1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO CLARIFY DEFINITIONS AND REMEDIES UNDER THE MOTOR
3	VEHICLE DEALERS AND MANUFACTURERS LICENSING LAWS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-286(10) reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 20-286. Definitions.
7	The following definitions apply in this Article:
8	
9	(10) Motor vehicle. – Any motor propelled vehicle, trailer or semitrailer,
10	required to be registered under the laws of this State.
11	a. "New motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle which has never
12	been the subject of a sale other than between new motor vehicle
13	dealers, or between manufacturer and dealer of the same
14	franchise.vehicle:
15	<u>1.</u> Which has never been the subject of a sale other than
16	between new motor vehicle dealers or between the
17	manufacturer and dealer of the same franchise; or
18	2. Which is offered for sale by a new motor vehicle dealer
19	and the vehicle's odometer mileage is 1,000 miles or less.
20	For the purposes of this Article, a motor vehicle that has
21	previously been the subject of a sale by a new motor vehicle
22	dealer may nonetheless be considered new and represented to
23	the public as a new motor vehicle, so long as the vehicle's
24	odometer mileage does not exceed 1,000 miles:
25	I. Whether that sale was conditional or
26	unconditional;
27	II. Whether or not documents transferring title to the
28	vehicle were executed and submitted to the

1	III. Whether or not the title to the vehicle was
2	transferred.
3	b. "Used motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle other than
4	described in paragraph (10)a above."
5	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-348 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
6	"(c) A person claiming injury or damage as a result of any of the following shall
7	elect between the remedies provided under subsection (a) of this section and the
8	remedies afforded by other statutes and under the common law:
9	(1) Actions or conduct violating this Article.
10	(2) <u>A violation of G.S. 20-71.4.</u>
11	(3) Arising out of the sale, maintenance, or repair of a motor vehicle.
12	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
