#### **BILL SUMMARY:**

House Bill 691 increases the amount of the general municipal vehicle tax Carrboro may impose from \$15 to \$25. The second edition adds a provision authorizing the Town of Black Mountain, as a contractor for the provision of mass transit services, to impose the \$5 vehicle tax for public transportation. The bill becomes effective when it becomes law.

### **ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

According to the Orange County Tax Assessor's Office, there are 11,794 vehicles listed in the Town of Carrboro. Multiplying this number by the \$10 proposed fee increase results in the \$117,940 figure for additional revenue.

Based on information from the Buncombe County Tax Assessor, FRD estimates that approximately 6,900 vehicles are listed in the Town of Black Mountain. Multiplying this number by the \$5 proposed fee results in \$34,500 in additional revenue.
