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| 2 | AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE COMMISSION ON STATE PROPERTY AND TO |

| 4 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Article 78 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is repealed, |
| 6 | and the Commission on State Property is abolished. |
| 7 | SECTION 2. The contract, entered into by the Commission on January 15, |
| 8 | 2007, for technical or professional services, is terminated in accordance with paragraph |
| 9 | 13 of the contract, as of the effective date of this act. This act shall constitute written |
| 10 | notice to the contractor. |
| 11 | SECTION 3. The elimination of any employee positions in the Commission |
| 12 | on State Property required by this act shall be deemed an economy in the State Budget, |
| 13 | and any employee affected shall be entitled to benefits pursuant to G.S. 143-27.2. |
| 14 | SECTION 4. No finding or determination by the Commission before the |
| 15 | effective date of this act that a property is or should be surplus is binding on the |
| 16 | Department of Administration, nor is any selection by the Commission of any person, |
| 17 | firm, or corporation to provide brokerage services with respect to any property. The |
| 18 | determinations that any property is surplus, that there is a need for brokerage services, |
| 19 | and the selection of a provider for any such needed services are in the sole discretion of |
| 20 | the Department of Administration. |
| 21 | SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law. |
