A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ANNEX DIVIDED PARCELS TO THE TOWN OF EARL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 787 of the 1971 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 207 of the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"**Sec. 3.** The corporate limits and boundaries of the Town of Earl in Cleveland County shall be one-half mile in every direction from the center of Lot No. 58 of said Town. In addition to any other property added to the corporate limits in accordance with law, the corporate limits of the Town also include the remainder of any parcel that under the previous sentence is partially in the corporate limits and that has not previously been annexed."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act becomes effective on June 30 next following the adoption by the Town of Earl of an ordinance particularly identifying the property added to the corporate limits by Section 1 of this act and filing of a map with the Register of Deeds of Cleveland County and with the Board of Elections of Cleveland County.
