A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ALEXANDER AND WILKES COUNTIES  
TO SUPPORT ENTREPRENEURIAL PROJECTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Alexander County the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used to support entrepreneurial projects that would assist individuals or groups in the county to establish small businesses and to attract new companies to the area.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Wilkes County the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be used to support entrepreneurial projects that would assist individuals or groups in the county to establish small businesses and to attract new companies to the area.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
