12	(e) Defei	nse It shall be a defense to a violation of subsection (b)(2)a. of this	
13	section if the o	perator of a motorcycle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(27)d., or a bicycle	
14	shows all of the	following:	
15	<u>(1)</u>	The operator brought the motorcycle or bicycle to a complete stop at	
16		the intersection or stop bar where a steady red light was being emitted	
17		in the direction of the operator.	
18	<u>(2)</u>	The intersection is controlled by a vehicle actuated traffic signal using	
19		an inductive loop to activate the traffic signal.	
20	<u>(3)</u>	No other vehicle was sitting or standing at the intersection.	
21	<u>(4)</u>	No pedestrians were attempting to cross at or near the intersection.	
22	<u>(5)</u>	The inductive loop that actuated the traffic signal was not activated by	
23		the motorcycle or bicycle.	
24	<u>(6)</u>	At least one full traffic signal light cycle had occurred or a minimum	
25		of three minutes has elapsed prior to entering the intersection."	
26	SEC	<b>FION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to	
27	offenses committed on or after that date.
