A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD GASOLINE-POWERED GOLF CARTS TO THOSE GOLF

CARTS THAT MAY BE REGULATED IN THE TOWNS OF
ELIZABETHTOWN, ROSE HILL, AND BLADENBORO.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of S.L. 2005-11 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, a town may, by ordinance, regulate the operation of <u>gasoline-powered or</u> electric golf carts on any public street or road within the town.

By ordinance, a town may require the registration of golf carts, charge a fee for the registration, specify the persons authorized to operate golf carts, and specify the required equipment, load limits, and the hours and methods of operation of golf carts."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
