HIGHWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF THIRTY-FIVE MILES PER

HOUR OR LESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of S.L. 2004-108, as rewritten by S.L. 2005-305, S.L. 2006-25, S.L. 2006-116, and S.L. 2007-4 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act applies to the Towns of Beaufort, Highlands, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act applies to the Towns of

Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act applies to the Towns of Atlantic Beach, Burgaw, Carolina Beach, Cramerton, Dallas, Duck, Emerald Isle,

- 12 Indian Beach, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Kure Beach, Lowell, Nags Head, Oakboro,
- Ocean Isle Beach, North Topsail Beach, Pine Knoll Shores, Stanley, Surf City, Topsail
- 14 Beach, and Wrightsville Beach, the Cities of Albemarle, Belmont, Cherryville,
- 15 Gastonia, Kings Mountain, Mount Holly, and Rockingham and the Counties of
- 16 Cleveland, Currituck, Gaston, Surry, and Wilkes only. The term 'municipal employee'
- shall include employees of a county."
