## SESSION LAW 2008-85 HOUSE BILL 2127

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE LAW ESTABLISHING REGIONAL INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCILS UNDER THE LAWS RELATING TO EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES FOR CHILDREN FROM BIRTH TO FIVE YEARS OF AGE WITH DISABILITIES, SO AS TO SAVE FUNDS AND AVOID DUPLICATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 143B-179.5A is repealed. **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2008.
