A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MOVEMENT OF TRAILER FRAMES NOT
2 EXCEEDING FOURTEEN FEET IN WIDTH TO ANOTHER LOCATION NO
3 FARTHER THAN THREE MILES AWAY FROM THE POINT OF ORIGIN FOR
4 CONTINUED MANUFACTURING OF THE TRANSFER TRAILER WITH AN
5 ANNUAL PERMIT.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-115.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 "(j) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a manufacturer of trailer
10 frames, with a permit issued pursuant to G.S. 20-119, is authorized to transport the
11 trailer frame to another location within three miles of the first place of manufacture to
12 the location of completion on any public street or highway if the width of the trailer
13 frame does not exceed 14 feet and oversize markings and safety flags are used during
14 transport. Trailer frames transported pursuant to this subsection shall not exceed 7,000
15 pounds, and the vehicle towing the trailer frame shall have a towing capacity greater
16 than 10,000 pounds and necessary towing equipment. The transport of trailer frames
17 under this subsection shall only be done during daylight hours."

18 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-119(b) reads as rewritten:

19 "(b) Upon the issuance of a special permit for an oversize or overweight vehicle
20 by the Department of Transportation in accordance with this section, the applicant shall
21 pay to the Department for a single trip permit a fee of twelve dollars (\$12.00) for each
22 dimension over lawful dimensions, including height, length, width, and weight up to
23 132,000 pounds. For overweight vehicles, the applicant shall pay to the Department for
24 a single trip permit in addition to the fee imposed by the previous sentence a fee of three
25 dollars (\$3.00) per 1,000 pounds over 132,000 pounds.

26 Upon the issuance of an annual permit for a single vehicle, the applicant shall pay a
27 fee in accordance with the following schedule:

3	Annual Permit to Move Other Commodities	\$100.00

4 In addition to the fees set out in this subsection, applications for permits that require
5 an engineering study for pavement or structures or other special conditions or
6 considerations shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable application fee of one hundred
7 dollars (\$100.00).

8 This subsection does not apply to farm equipment or machinery being used at the
9 time for agricultural purposes, nor to the moving of a house as provided for by the
10 license and permit requirements of Article 16 of this Chapter. Fees will not be assessed
11 for permits for oversize and overweight vehicles issued to any agency of the United
12 States Government or the State of North Carolina, its agencies, institutions,
13 subdivisions, or municipalities if the vehicle is registered in the name of the agency."

14 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
