2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA  
3 BIOTECHNOLOGY CENTER FOR THE HISTORICALLY MINORITY  
4 UNIVERSITY INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT (HIG) PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North  
7 Carolina Biotechnology Center the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars  
8 (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be used for the  
9 Historically Minority University Infrastructure Grant (HIG) program. HIG is proposed  
10 as a way to build capacity in the life sciences at North Carolina's public historically  
11 minority universities in alignment with the recommendations of the University of North  
12 Carolina Tomorrow Commission. Eligible universities include: Elizabeth City State  
13 University, Fayetteville State University, North Carolina Agricultural and Technical  
14 State University, North Carolina Central University, University of North Carolina at  
15 Pembroke, and Winston-Salem State University.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
