Short Title: Hemby Bridge Elections. (Local) Representative Blackwood. **Sponsors:** Referred to: Local Government II, if favorable, Election Law and Campaign Finance Reform. February 27, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF HEMBY BRIDGE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY PLURALITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Section 4.1 of the Charter of Hemby Bridge, being S.L. 1998-143, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 4.1. Conduct of Town Elections. Town officers shall be elected on a nonpartisan election and runoff-plurality basis and results determined as provided in G.S. 163-293. <u>163-292.</u>"

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
