GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA SESSION 2007

HOUSE BILL 382 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF HEMBY BRIDGE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY PLURALITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4.1 of the Charter of Hemby Bridge, being S.L. 1998-143, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4.1. **Conduct of Town Elections.** Town officers shall be elected on a nonpartisan election and runoff plurality basis and results determined as provided in G.S. 163-293. 163-292."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
