1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ANY STATE LOTTERY ADVERTISING RELATED TO
3	HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGIATE SPORTS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 18C-130(e) reads as rewritten:
6	"(e) Lottery advertising shall be tastefully designed and presented in a manner to
7	minimize the appeal of lottery games to minors. No advertising or sponsorship may take
8	place in connection with any high school or collegiate sport or high school or collegiate
9	sporting event, or be placed in any high school or collegiate sporting venue. The use of
10	cartoon characters or of false, misleading, or deceptive information in lottery
11	advertising is prohibited. All advertising promoting the sale of lottery tickets or shares
12	for a particular game shall include the actual or estimated overall odds of winning the
13	game."
14	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law. No new contracts
15	may be entered into that violate this act, and any existing contracts may not be renewed
16	or extended in any manner.
