2 AN ACT TO MOVE ELECTIONS FOR THE TOWN OF ROPER TO THE
3 TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER IN
4 ODD-NUMBERED YEARS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Charter of the Town of Roper, being Chapter 24, Private
7 Laws of 1907, is amended by adding a new section to read:

8 "Sec. 3. That the officers of said corporation shall consist of a mayor, three
9 commissioners, regular and special policemen, clerk and treasurer, and such other
10 officers as the town may elect, and the following named persons shall fill the offices of
11 mayor and commissioners from their qualification until the first Tuesday after the first
12 Monday in May, one thousand nine hundred and seven, and until their successors are
13 elected and qualified: For mayor, Thomas W. Blount, and for commissioners, L.G.
14 Roper, N.B. Mizell, and W.C. Thompson. Elections for mayor and
15 commissioner shall be held at the time set forth in G.S. 163-279."

16 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to elections held in 2009 and thereafter for the
17 Town of Roper.

18 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
