2	AN ACT TO REDUCE THE TERMS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE
3	CITY OF ASHEVILLE FROM FIVE YEARS TO FOUR YEARS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 157-5(d) reads as rewritten:
6	"(d) The mayor shall designate overlapping terms of not less than one nor more
7	than five years for the commissioners first appointed. Thereafter, the term of office shall
8	be five four years. A commissioner shall hold office until his or her successor has been
9	appointed and has qualified. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term. A majority
10	of the commissioners shall constitute a quorum. The mayor shall file with the city clerk
11	a certificate of the appointment or reappointment of any commissioner and such
12	certificate shall be conclusive evidence of the due and proper appointment of such
13	commissioner. A commissioner shall receive no compensation for his or her services
14	but he or she shall be entitled to the necessary expenses including traveling expenses
15	incurred in the discharge of his or her duties."
16	SECTION 2. This act applies to the City of Asheville only.
17	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to terms
10	of office commonsing on or often that data

18 of office commencing on or after that date.
