A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF THREE HUNDRED
2 APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IS
3 AUTHORIZED TO PRODUCE THE GOLD STAR SPECIAL PLATE AND TO
4 ELIMINATE THE FEE FOR THE GOLD STAR SPECIAL PLATE; TO CHANGE
5 THE RECIPIENT OF FUNDS FROM THE OMEGA PSI PHI SPECIAL PLATE
6 FROM THE UNITED NEGRO COLLEGE FUND, INC., TO THE CAROLINA
7 UPLIFT FOUNDATION, INC., TO BE USED FOR YOUTH ACTIVITY AND
8 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS; TO ELIMINATE THE ADDITIONAL FEE
9 AMOUNT FOR THE BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PLATE; TO INCREASE
10 THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE NC COASTAL FEDERATION PLATE, TO
11 AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE THE
12 FOLLOWING NEW SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES: PROSTATE
13 CANCER AWARENESS, JUVENILE DIABETES RESEARCH, BREAST
14 CANCER EARLIER DETECTION, BRAIN INJURY AWARENESS, NC TENNIS
15 FOUNDATION, ALS RESEARCH, NATIONAL KIDNEY FOUNDATION, AIDS
16 AWARENESS, TRIANGLE NATIVE AMERICAN SOCIETY, HOME CARE
17 AND HOSPICE, AND HOSPICE CARE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF
18 MOTOR VEHICLES TO ASSIGN A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE FOR
19 THE PRESIDENT OF THE NORTH CAROLINA COMMUNITY COLLEGES
20 SYSTEM; AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS IN THE STATUTE
21 CONCERNING ASSIGNMENTS OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES TO
22 STATE GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS.

24 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

25 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

26 "(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number
27 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina,

1 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of
2 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and
3 weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is
4 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a
5 trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for
6 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

7 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the
8 Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for
9 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have
10 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and
11 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying
12 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The
13 following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The
14 design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division
15 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

40 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

41 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
42 plates:

2 in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
3 "Find a Cure" beside the logo of a red ribbon on the left side of the
4 plate.

- 6 (6a) ALS Research. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
7 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
8 "Nothing Less, Cure ALS" and the logo of the nonprofit group the
9 ALS Association, Jim "Catfish" Hunter Chapter.
10 ...
- 11 (14a) Brain Injury Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
12 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
13 phrase "Brain Injury Awareness" and the logo of the nonprofit group
14 Brain Injury Association of North Carolina, Inc.
15 ...
- 16 (15a) Breast Cancer Earlier Detection. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
17 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
18 the phrase "Friends for An Earlier Breast Cancer Test."
19 ...
- 20 (54) Gold Star Lapel Button. – Issuable to the recipient of the Gold Star
21 lapel button. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Gold Star lapel
22 button and the words "Gold Star".~~The Division may not issue the plate~~
23 ~~authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300~~
24 ~~applications for the plate.~~

- 26 (58a) Hospice Care. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
27 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
28 "Hospice Care" and the letters "HC" on the right side of the plate.
- 29 (58b) Home Care and Hospice. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
30 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
31 phrase "Home Care and Hospice" and the letters "HH" on the right
32 side of the plate.
33 ...
- 34 (61a) Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. – Issuable to the registered
35 owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate
36 shall bear the phrase "Juvenile Diabetes Research" and the "sneaker"
37 logo of the nonprofit group Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation
38 International, Inc.
39 ...
- 40 (78a) National Kidney Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
41 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a
42 phrase and logo selected by the Foundation.
43 ...

1 (85a) NC Tennis Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
 2 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
 3 phrase "Play Tennis" and the image of an implement of the tennis
 4 sport.

5 ...

6 (100a) Prostate Cancer Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
 7 motor vehicle. The plate shall bear the phrase "Prostate Cancer
 8 Awareness" and a representation of a blue ribbon. The Division must
 9 receive 300 or more applications for the plate before it may be
 10 developed.

12 (129a) Triangle Native American Society. – Issuable to the registered owner
 13 of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall
 14 bear the logo of the Triangle Native American Society and the letters
 15 "TNAS."

17 **SECTION 3.(a)** G.S. 20-79.5 reads as rewritten:

18 **"§ 20-79.5. Special registration plates for elected and appointed State government**
 19 **officials.**

20 (a) Plates. – The State government officials listed in this section are eligible for a
 21 special registration plate under G.S. 20-79.4. The plate shall bear the number designated
 22 in the following table for the position held by the official.

33	of the Board of Economic Development, nonlegislative members of the State Ports	
34	Authority, members of State boards and commissions, and for State employees. The	
35	Attorney General shall assign a number for the Attorney General's deputies and	
36	assistants.	
37	The first number assigned to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission is	
38	reserved for the Chair of that Commission. The remaining numbers shall be assigned to	
39	the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission members on the basis of seniority. The	
40	first number assigned to the Utilities Commission is reserved for the Chair of that	
41	Commission. The remaining numbers shall be assigned to the Utilities Commission	
42	members on the basis of seniority. The first number assigned to the <u>Post-Release</u>	
43	<u>Supervision and Parole Commission</u> is reserved for the Chair of that Commission. The	

1 remaining numbers shall be assigned to the Post-Release Supervision and Parole
2 Commission members on the basis of seniority."

3 **SECTION 3.(b)** This section becomes effective January 1, 2008.

4 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

5 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
6 registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor ~~award~~, award or a Gold Star Lapel
7 Button, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special
8 registration plates, including additional Legion of Valor, Gold Star Lapel Button, 100%
9 Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor
10 vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the
11 following amount:

SECTION 5. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

SECTION 6.(a) G.S. 20-81.12(b14) reads as rewritten:

"(b14) Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for an Omega Psi Phi Fraternity plate and receive any necessary licenses, without charge, from Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated, before the plate may be developed. The Division ~~shall~~must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity plates to ~~the United Negro College Fund, Inc., through the Winston-Salem Area Office for the benefit of UNCF colleges in this State.~~the Carolina Uplift Foundation, Inc., for youth activity and scholarship programs."

SECTION 6.(b) This section becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to fees transferred from the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account on or after that date.

SECTION 7. G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding the following new subsections to read:

"(b62) Home Care and Hospice. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Home Care and Hospice plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Home Care and Hospice plates to The Association for Home and Hospice Care of North Carolina for its educational programs in support of home care and hospice care in North Carolina.

(b63) Hospice Care. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the Hospice Care plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Hospice Care plates to The Carolinas Center for Hospice and End of Life Care for its programs in support of hospice care in North Carolina.

(b64) Breast Cancer Earlier Detection. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a Breast Cancer Earlier Detection plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Breast Cancer Earlier Detection plates to the Friends for An Earlier Breast Cancer Test, Inc., to support services to detect breast cancer earlier.

1 (b65) Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or
2 more applications for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation plate before the plate
3 may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
4 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Juvenile Diabetes Research
5 Foundation plates to the Triangle Eastern North Carolina Chapter of the Juvenile
6 Diabetes Research Foundation International, Inc., to provide funding for research to
7 cure diabetes. The Foundation must distribute the amount it receives to all Juvenile
8 Diabetes Research Foundation, Inc., chapters located in the State in equal shares.

9 (b66) AIDS Awareness. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
10 the AIDS Awareness plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
11 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account
12 derived from the sale of AIDS Awareness plates to The Alliance of AIDS
13 Services-Carolina for its programs in support of AIDS awareness in North Carolina.

14 (b67) ALS Research. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
15 ALS Research plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
16 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
17 from the sale of ALS Research plates to the ALS Association, Jim "Catfish" Hunter
18 Chapter, to help provide funding for research to cure amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and
19 provide support to families who have a loved one suffering from the disease.

20 (b68) Brain Injury Awareness. – The Division must receive 300 or more
21 applications for the Brain Injury Awareness plate before the plate may be developed.
22 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
23 Plate Account derived from the sale of Brain Injury Awareness plates to the Brain
24 Injury Association of North Carolina, Inc., for support services to individuals with
25 traumatic brain injuries.

26 (b69) National Kidney Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more
27 applications for a National Kidney Foundation plate before the plate may be developed.
28 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
29 Plate Account derived from the sale of National Kidney Foundation plates to the
30 National Kidney Foundation of North Carolina, Inc., to support the Foundation's
31 services for the detection, prevention, and treatment of diseases of the kidney and
32 urinary tract.

33 (b70) NC Tennis Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
34 for the NC Tennis Foundation plate before the plate may be developed. The Division
35 must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate
36 Account derived from the sale of NC Tennis Foundation plates to the North Carolina
37 Tennis Foundation, Inc., to provide funding for development and growth of tennis as a
38 sport in North Carolina.

39 (b71) Triangle Native American Society. – The Division must receive 300 or more
40 applications for the Triangle Native American Society plate before the plate may be
41 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
42 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Triangle Native American
43 Society plates to the Triangle Native American Society, Inc., to provide scholarships for

1 Native American Indians living in North Carolina who attend accredited
 2 State-supported colleges and universities in North Carolina."

3 **SECTION 8.(a)** G.S. 20-79.7(a), as enacted by Section 4 of this act, reads
 4 as rewritten:

5 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
 6 registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran,
 7 and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional
 8 Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to
 9 the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional
 10 fee in the following amount:

12 plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the
13 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust
14 Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation
15 Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

 17 motor ~~vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12.~~ vehicle. The plate
 18 shall bear the phrase "Early Detection Saves Lives" and a
 19 representation of a pink ribbon. The Division must receive 300 or
 20 more applications for the plate before it may be developed."

21 **SECTION 8.(e)** This section becomes effective October 1, 2007, and any
 22 funds remaining in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account on that date
 23 that are derived from sales of the Breast Cancer Awareness plate must be transferred to
 24 the Friends for An Earlier Breast Cancer Test, Inc.

25 **SECTION 9.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it
 26 becomes law.
