The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 105-449.60(1) reads as rewritten:	
"(1	1) Biodiesel. – Any fuel or mixture of fuels derived in whole or in part
	from agricultural products or animal fats or wastes from these products
	or fats. A fuel comprised of mono-alkyl esters of long chain fatty acids
	derived from vegetable oils or animal fats, designated B100 and
	meeting the requirements of the American Society for Testing and
	Materials (ASTM) D-6751. The term also includes blends of biodiesel
	with petroleum-based diesel fuel, designated BXX where XX
	represents the percentage of volume of biodiesel fuel in the blend, that

meet the requirements of ASTM D-6751."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
