5	CHILDREN TO REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 138A-24(a)(1) reads as rewritten:
8	"(a) Any statement of economic interest filed under this Article shall be on a form
9	prescribed by the Commission and sworn to by the filing person. Answers must be
10	provided to all questions. The form shall include the following information about the
11	filing person and the filing person's immediate family:
12	(1) The name, home address, occupation, employer, and business of the
13	person, person, except that a justice or judge may provide a business
14	address instead of the home address. The justice or judge shall provide
15	a home address on a separate form which shall be held confidential by
16	the Commission and is not a public record. The name and home
17	address of any minor child of the justice or judge who is an immediate
18	family member, and the home address of the spouse of the justice or
19	judge, shall be provided to the Commission on a separate form which
20	shall be held confidential by the Commission and is not a public
21	record. The justice or judge shall list on the public form the initials of
22	any minor child for whom a separate report is provided under this
23	subdivision.

25	SECTION 2 This act is effective when it becomes law.
