AN ACT TO REMOVE A PORTION OF LAKE WA

AN ACT TO REMOVE A PORTION OF LAKE WACCAMAW STATE PARK FROM THE STATE NATURE AND HISTORIC PRESERVE AND THE STATE PARKS SYSTEM TO ALLOW FOR BRIDGE REALIGNMENT ON BELLA COOLA ROAD, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-260.10 reads as rewritten:

"§ 143-260.10. Components of State Nature and Historic Preserve.

The following are components of the State Nature and Historic Preserve accepted by the North Carolina General Assembly pursuant to G.S. 143-260.8:

12 All lands and waters within the boundaries of the following units of (1) the State Parks System as of 1 May 2007: Baldhead Island State 13 Natural Area, Bay Tree Lake State Park, Beech Creek Bog State 14 15 Natural Area, Bullhead Mountain State Natural Area, Bushy Lake State Natural Area, Carolina Beach State Park, Carvers Creek State 16 Park, Chimney Rock State Park, Cliffs of the Neuse State Park, 17 18 Chowan Swamp State Natural Area, Dismal Swamp State Park, Elk Knob State Park, Fort Fisher State Recreation Area, Fort Macon State 19 20 Park, Goose Creek State Park, Gorges State Park, Haw River State Park, Hammocks Beach State Park, Jones Lake State Park, Lake 21 22 Norman State Park, Lake Waccamaw State Park, Lea Island State 23 Natural Area, Lower Haw River State Natural Area, Lumber River 24 State Park, Mayo River State Park, Medoc Mountain State Park, Merchants Millpond State Park, Mitchells Millpond State Natural 25 Area, Mount Mitchell State Park, Mountain Bog State Natural Area, 26 Occoneechee Mountain State Natural Area, Pettigrew State Park, Pilot 27 Mountain State Park, Raven Rock State Park, Run Hill State Natural 28 29 Area, Sandy Run Savannas State Natural Area, Singletary Lake State

Park, Theodore Roosevelt State Natural Area, and Weymouth 1 2 Woods-Sandhills Nature Preserve. 3 4 All lands and waters within the boundaries of Lake Waccamaw State <u>(20)</u> 5 Park as of May 1, 2007, with the exception of the following tracts: The 6 portions of that certain tract or parcel of land at Lake Waccamaw State 7 Park in Columbus County described in Deed Book 835, Page 590, 8 containing 48,210 square feet and being the portion of this tract shown 9 as new R/W and permanent utility easement on drawing prepared by 10 State of North Carolina Department of Transportation entitled "Map of 11 Proposed Right of Way Property of State of North Carolina (Parks and Recreation) Columbus County" for Tip B-3830 on SR 1947 (Bella 12 Coola Road) done by John E. Kaukola, PLS No. 3999 and compiled 13 14 1-18-2008, and filed with the State Property Office. The tracts 15 excluded from the State Nature and Historic Preserve under this section are deleted from the State Parks System pursuant to 16 17 G.S. 113-44.14. The State of North Carolina may only exchange this 18 land for other land for the expansion of Lake Waccamaw State Park or sell this land and use the proceeds for that purpose. The State may not 19 20 otherwise sell or exchange this land."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
