1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WITH AN EXEMPTION FROM
3 ADVANCING COURT FEES IN CHILD SUPPORT ACTIONS, CHILD ABUSE
4 ACTIONS, AND OTHER ACTIONS FILED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
5 SOCIAL SERVICES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 SECTION 1. Section 30.10(d) of S.L. 2007-323 is repealed.

8 SECTION 2. Section 30.10(h) of S.L. 2007-323 reads as rewritten:

9 "SECTION 30.10.(h) Subsection (d) of this act becomes effective July 1, 2008.

10 The remainder of this act-section becomes effective August 1, 2007, and applies to all
11 costs assessed or collected on or after that date."

12 SECTION 3. G.S. 7A-317 reads as rewritten:

13 "§ 7A-317. Counties and municipalities not required to advance certain fees.

14 Counties and municipalities are ~~not~~ required to advance costs except for the
15 following:

16 (1) ~~the~~ The facilities fee, fee.

17 (2) ~~the~~ The General Court of Justice fee, fee.

18 (3) ~~the~~ The miscellaneous fees enumerated in G.S. 7A-308, or
19 G.S. 7A-308 in child support actions, child abuse actions, and other
20 actions filed by the department of social services.

21 (4) ~~the~~ The civil process fees enumerated in G.S. 7A-311."

22 SECTION 4. Section 3 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2008. The
23 remainder of this act becomes effective June 30, 2008.
