A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW PROHIBITING THE TAKING OF DEER FROM A  
BOAT IN BERTIE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 5 of S.L. 2001-367 reads as rewritten:

**"SECTION 5.** It is unlawful to take deer from any vessel in the Roanoke River  
~~above the U.S. Highway 17 bridge, or its tributaries~~ whether the vessel is under power  
or not, except that a vessel may be used for transportation to and from otherwise lawful  
hunting stands upon land owned or leased by a person or upon which a person has  
written permission to hunt."

**SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Bertie County.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to acts  
committed on or after that date.
