- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO
2 CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A
3 PERSON WHO MURDERS A PREGNANT WOMAN SHALL BE GUILTY OF A
4 SEPARATE OFFENSE OF MURDER IN THE RESULTING DEATH OF THE
5 FETUS.
6 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:
7 **SECTION 1.** The 2007 General Assembly may consider "A BILL TO BE
8 ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO MURDERS A
9 PREGNANT WOMAN SHALL BE GUILTY OF A SEPARATE OFFENSE OF
10 MURDER IN THE RESULTING DEATH OF THE FETUS."
11 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
