A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN THE CITY  
3 OF ARCHDALE TO BE CONDUCTED IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS, AND  
4 TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF CURRENT OFFICERS TO THE NEW  
5 ELECTION SCHEDULE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7       **SECTION 1.** Regular municipal elections shall be held in the City of  
8 Archdale biennially in even-numbered years, but shall otherwise be conducted in  
9 accordance with general law governing municipal elections. The mayor and members of  
10 the council shall be elected by the nonpartisan plurality election method provided for in  
11 G.S. 163-292.

12       **SECTION 2.** No regular election shall be conducted in the City of Archdale  
13 in 2007. The term of the mayor elected in 2005 is extended until the organizational  
14 meeting after the 2008 regular municipal election held in accordance with Section 1 of  
15 this act. The terms of the council members elected in 2003 are extended until the  
16 organizational meeting after the 2008 regular municipal election held in accordance  
17 with Section 1 of this act. The terms of the council members elected in 2005 are  
18 extended until the organizational meeting after the 2010 regular municipal election held  
19 in accordance with Section 1 of this act.

20       **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
