3		than ten percent (10%) ethanol intended for use as a motor vehicle
4		fuel.
5		(2) "E-blend" means a blend of petroleum and ethanol including more
6		than ten percent (10%) ethanol intended for use as a motor vehicle
7		fuel.
8		(3) "Listed" means equipment or materials included on a list published by
9		an approved testing laboratory, inspection agency, or other
10		organization concerned with current production evaluation that
11		maintains periodic inspection of production of listed equipment or
12		materials, and whose listing states that equipment or materials comply
13		with approved nationally recognized standards and have been tested or
14		evaluated and found suitable for use in a specified manner."
