"§ 127A-210. Short title. 11 This Article shall be known and may be cited as the North Carolina National Guard 12 Death Benefit and Dependent Higher Education Fund. 13 14 "§ 127A-211. Purpose. 15 The General Assembly of North Carolina finds that: The North Carolina National Guard has a proud tradition of military 16 (1) 17 service with thousands of North Carolinians having answered the call of the nation and served in the North Carolina National Guard. 18 Members of the North Carolina National Guard are now being asked to 19 <u>(2)</u> 20 serve extended periods of active duty in combat areas. 21 Members of the North Carolina National Guard provide North (3) 22 Carolina and its citizens valuable benefits through their service inside 23 this State and through their recently extended periods of active duty in 24 combat areas outside North Carolina.

There have been instances in which dependents of members of the

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to establish the North Carolina National Guard Death Benefit and Dependent Higher Education Fund.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.

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
