1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ALLOW FOR-HIRE FARM TRACTORS AND IMPLEMENTS OF
3	HUSBANDRY TO BE EXEMPT FROM REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS, TO
4	INCREASE THE DISTANCE THE FARM TRACTOR OR IMPLEMENT OF
5	HUSBANDRY MAY TRAVEL WITHOUT HAVING TO BE A REGISTERED
6	VEHICLE, TO INCREASE THE LENGTH ALLOWED FOR TRUCKS
7	TRANSPORTING COTTON, AND TO INCREASE THE WIDTH ALLOWED
8	FOR VEHICLES WITH SELF-LOADING BEDS THAT TRANSPORT COTTON.
9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51(5) reads as rewritten:
11	"§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.
12	The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of
13	title:
14	
15	(5) Farm tractors equipped with rubber tires and trailers or semitrailers
16	when attached thereto and when used by a farmer, his tenant, agent, or
17	employee in transporting his own farm implements, farm supplies, or
18	farm products from place to place on the same farm, from one farm to
19	another, from farm to market, or from market to farm. This exemption
20	shall extend also to any tractor, implement of husbandry, and trailer or
21	semitrailer while on any trip within a radius of 10-50 miles from the
22	point of loading, provided that the vehicle does not exceed a speed of
23	35 miles per hour. This section shall not be construed as granting any
24	exemption to farm tractors, implements of husbandry, and trailers or
25	semitrailers which are operated on a for-hire basis, whether money or
26	some other thing of value is paid or given for the use of such tractors,
27	implements of husbandry, and trailers or semitrailers.

29	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-116(d) reads as rewritten:

3	(d)	Maximum Length The following maximum lengths apply to vehicles. A
4	truck-tra	ctor and semitrailer shall be regarded as two vehicles for the purpose of
5	determin	ing lawful length and license taxes.
6		(1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a single vehicle
7		having two or three axles shall not exceed 40 feet in length overall of
8		dimensions inclusive of front and rear bumpers.
9		(2) Trucks transporting unprocessed cotton from farm to gin shall not
10		exceed 4850 feet in length overall of dimensions inclusive of front and
11		rear bumpers.
12		(3) Recreational vehicles shall not exceed 45 feet in length overall,
13		excluding bumpers and mirrors."
14		SECTION 3. G.S. 20-116 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
15	"§ 20-11	6. Size of vehicles and loads.
16		
17	<u>(1)</u>	Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent the operation of a vehicle
18	with a w	idth not exceeding 110 inches which is equipped with a self-loading bed and is
19	designed	exclusively to be used to transport compressed seed cotton from a farm to a
20	cotton gi	<u>n.</u> "
21		SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
