A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF STATE PERSONNEL TO DEVELOP AN 3 EMPLOYEE BENEFITS STATEMENT THAT REFLECTS THE CURRENT VALUE OF 4 EMPLOYEE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO STATE EMPLOYEES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Office of State Personnel shall conduct a study on development 6 7 of an employee benefits statement that reflects the current value of employee benefits provided to active State employees. For the purposes of this act, the term "benefits statement" means a 8 9 document showing an employee's total compensation, including all cash income and the value 10 of all employee benefits.

11 SECTION 2. The personalized benefits statement developed for individual State employees must include a determination of at least the value of: 12

- Employee and dependent coverage under the State Health Plan for Teachers (1)and State Employees.
- Employee, survivors, and dependent coverage under the Teachers' and State (2)Employees' Retirement System.

SECTION 3. The Office of State Personnel shall submit to the General Assembly 17 and to the Fiscal Research Division by December 31, 2009, a detailed written report on the 18 development of the employee benefits statement, including a recommended implementation 19 20 schedule and an estimate of the costs of any information technologies or modifications 21 necessary to generate the statements.
