2	AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE DAVIE COUNTY BOARD		
3	OF EDUCATION FROM SIX TO SEVEN AND CHANGE THE TERMS OF OFFICE		
4	FROM SIX YEARS TO FOUR YEARS.		
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 1242 of the 1967 Session Laws reads as		
7	rewritten:		
8	"Section 1. The Board of Education of Davie County shall, on and after the first Monday in		
9	April, 1969, July, 2012, consist of six-seven members who shall be elected in the manner		
10	hereinafter provided."		
11	SECTION 2. Section 2 of Chapter 1242 of the 1967 Session Laws reads as		
12	rewritten:		
13	"Sec. 2. (a) At the same time the primary election for county officers is held in Davie		
14	County in 1968, and biennially thereafter, there shall be held a nonpartisan election to elect two		
15	members of the Board of Education of Davie County, to serve for six-year terms. County.		
16	(b) In 2012, three members of the Davie County Board of Education shall be elected.		
17	The person receiving the highest number of votes is elected to a six-year term. The two persons		
18	receiving the next highest numbers of votes are elected to four-year terms.		
19	(c) In 2014, two members of the Davie County Board of Education are elected to		
20	four-year terms.		
21	(d) In 2016 and quadrennially thereafter, four members of the Davie County Board of		
22	Education are elected to four-year terms.		
23	(e) In 2018 and quadrennially thereafter, three members of the Davie County Board of		
24	Education are elected to four-year terms." SECTION 3. Section 3 of Chapter 1242 of the 1967 Session Laws reads as

26	rewritten:	Dach condidate shall file	his condident, without reference to any political party
27 28	"Sec. 3. Each candidate shall file his candidacy, without reference to any political party affiliation, with the Chairman of the County Board of Elections within the time now provided		
28 29	for the filing of candidates for any other county office. A filing fee of five dollars (\$5.00) shall		
29 30	be paid by each candidate. There shall be a separate ballot provided by the County Board of		
31	Elections with the names of the candidates printed thereon with appropriate instructions for use		
32	in the election of members of the Board of Education, and no political party affiliation shall be		
33	shown on said ballot. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the election		
34	of 1968, and biennially thereafter, shall be certified as the duly elected members of the Board		
35	of Education."		





SECTION 4. Section 4 of Chapter 1242 of the 1967 Session Laws, as amended by 1 2 Chapter 5 of the 1979 Session Laws and Chapter 307 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as 3 rewritten: 4 "Sec. 4. The two members of the Board of Education of Davie County elected in 1968 and 5 biennially thereafter shall be inducted into and take the oath of office on the first Monday in 6 July following their election, and shall serve for terms of six years and until their successors are 7 elected and qualified. All members of the Board of Education of Davie County who are in 8 office and acting as such members prior to the first Monday in April, 1969, shall complete their 9 respective terms of office. The said Board of Education shall consist of six members serving 10 six-year terms with two vacancies occurring every two years." 11 SECTION 5. This act is effective upon ratification. It does not affect the terms of

12 office of persons elected in 2006, 2008, or 2010.
