## SESSION LAW 2009-144 HOUSE BILL 482

## AN ACT RELATING TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF UNUSED SICK LEAVE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-336 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(d) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules relating to the reinstatement of unused sick leave when an employee who was employed on a 10-month contract at the time of separation returns to employment on a 10-month contract. Under these rules, the maximum period of separation after which unused sick leave is reinstated shall be three calendar months longer for school personnel employed on a 10-month contract than for school personnel employed on a 12-month contract."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009.
