5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 42 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
7	a new section to read as follows:
8	" <u>§ 42-30.1. Time within which trial is set.</u>
9	If the time set for trial in the summons is less than two days after service has been made on
10	the defendant as provided in G.S. 42-29, excluding weekends and legal holidays, the magistrate
11	shall order the trial to be continued to provide at least two days, excluding weekends and legal
12	holidays, from the date of service to the date of trial."
13	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
