**SENATE BILL 762**

Short Title: Salary Supplement/Some Automotive Teachers. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE A SALARY SUPPLEMENT OF  
TWELVE PERCENT TO NATIONALLY CERTIFIED TEACHERS IN HIGH SCHOOL  
AUTOMOTIVE PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** A teacher in a high school automotive program who is certified as an instructor by the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) shall receive an annual salary supplement of twelve percent (12%), paid on a monthly basis, in addition to the compensation provided for a teacher with his or her level of academic preparation.

**SECTION 1.(b)** The State Board of Education shall adopt rules for the provision of the salary supplement pursuant to this act that shall include a process by which a teacher may verify that:

- (1) The teacher is still employed by a local school administrative unit as a full-time employee;
- (2) The required certification has been attained and has not lapsed; and
- (3) The teacher meets all the qualifications to work as a high school automotive teacher in this State.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of nine hundred four thousand four hundred seventy-four dollars (\$904,474) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred four thousand four hundred seventy-four dollars (\$904,474) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
