1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF RICK RHYNE,
2 MOORE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTY, KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

3 Whereas, Rick Rhyne was born January 27, 1953, in Mecklenburg County, to
4 Richard Carlton Rhyne and Margie Thompson Rhyne; and

5 Whereas, Rick Rhyne had a long career in law enforcement, which began in 1974
6 when he joined the Pinehurst Police Department; and

7 Whereas, Rick Rhyne later served as Chief of Police of Foxfire Village until his
8 retirement in 2006; and

9 Whereas, Deputy Rhyne was a lifelong member of the North Carolina Association
10 of Chiefs of Police; and

11 Whereas, Rick Rhyne joined the Moore County Sheriff's office on April 28, 2007;
12 and

13 Whereas, Deputy Rhyne was respected and admired in his community and was
14 known to go beyond the call of duty to help those in need of assistance; and

15 Whereas, Deputy Rhyne was killed in the line of duty on December 8, 2011; and

16 Whereas, Deputy Rhyne is survived by his wife of 40 years, Wanda Thomas Rhyne;
17 a son, Lt. Col. Allen Rhyne; two grandchildren, Ruby Rhyne and Roxy Rhyne; two sisters,
18 Brenda Morton and Cindy Bennett; Now, therefore,

19 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

20 **SECTION 1.** The House of Representatives honors the life and service of Deputy
21 Rick Rhyne and expresses its appreciation for his service as a law enforcement officer and his
22 service to the people of Moore County.

23 **SECTION 2.** The House of Representatives extends its deepest sympathy to the
24 family of Rick Rhyne for the loss of a beloved family member.

25 **SECTION 3.** The Principal Clerk's Office shall transmit a certified copy of this
26 resolution to the family of Rick Rhyne.
