A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SIGNAGE DIRECTING TRAFFIC TO THE VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL, THE BEIRUT MEMORIAL, AND THE COASTAL CAROLINA STATE VETERANS CEMETERY.

13 14 **SECTION 1.** Of funds appropriated to the Department of Transportation from the Highway Fund for fiscal year 2011-2012, the Department shall expend up to the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for new signs located along NC Highway 24 and U.S. Highway 17 Bypass and Business routes and Western Boulevard in Jacksonville, Onslow County, for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, the Beirut Memorial, and the Coastal Carolina State Veterans Cemetery that replace old signs and add new signage, listing all memorials on one sign, at each of the various locations the signs currently appear along NC Highway 24 and U.S. Highway 17 Bypass and Business routes and Western Boulevard in Jacksonville, Onslow County.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
