A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SEASON FOR THE TRAPPING OF FOXES AND COYOTES
- 3 IN SURRY COUNTY.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season 6 for taking foxes and coyotes by trapping from October 15 through March 1 of each year.
- 7 **SECTION 2.** No season bag limit applies to foxes and coyotes taken under this act.
- 8 **SECTION 3.** The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of 9 foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.
- 10 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Surry County.
- 11 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
