## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PERSON WHO IS EIGHTEEN
3	YEARS OLD OR OLDER WEAR A HELMET WHILE OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE
4	ON A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY OR PUBLIC VEHICULAR AREA.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-140.4 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 20-140.4. Special provisions for motorcycles and mopeds.
8	(a) No person shall operate a motorcycle or moped upon a <u>public street or highway or</u>
9	public vehicular area:
10	(1) When the number of persons upon such motorcycle or moped, including the
11	operator, shall exceed the number of persons which it was designed to carry.
12	(2) Unless the <u>an</u> operator and all passengers <u>who are under 18 years of age</u>
13	thereon wear on their heads, with a retention strap properly secured, safety
14	helmets of a type that complies with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard
15	(FMVSS) 218.

17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
