5 OF REQUIRING THE VEHICLES TO BE TAKEN TO A REGIONAL MAINTENANCE
6 FACILITY, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
7 COMMISSION'S COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVE
8 ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.
9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Public Safety shall study the feasibility and
11 cost-effectiveness of contracting with local businesses to perform maintenance on State
12 Highway Patrol vehicles in lieu of requiring the vehicles to be taken to a regional maintenance
13 facility. The Department of Public Safety shall report the results of this study to the Joint
14 Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety by March 1, 2015.
15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2014.
