29	"(b) The sheriff shall issue a permit to carry a concealed handgun	to a person who
30	qualifies for a permit under G.S. 14-415.12. The permit shall be valid through	
31	period of five three years from the date of issuance."	
32	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and	applies to permits
33	issued on or after that date. A permit issued under Article 52A of Chapter	11 1
34	Statutes before December 1, 2013, shall remain valid until five years from	the date that the



permit was issued. A concealed handgun permit issued under Article 54B of Chapter 14 of the

- 1 General Statutes shall remain valid until five years from the date the permit was issued, unless
- the permit is revoked or suspended pursuant to G.S 14-415.18 prior to that date.
