April 15, 2013 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN AGENCY PREPARE A FISCAL NOTE WHEN REPEALING A RULE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 150B-4 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: If an agency proposes the repeal of an existing rule, the agency is not required to prepare a fiscal note on the proposed rule change as provided by this section." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all proposed

rules published in the North Carolina Register on or after that date.
