6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
8	"(4c) The Board of Governors shall require each constituent institution to develop
9	and implement a policy that recognizes the Cherokee language as a language
10	for which a student may satisfy the foreign language course requirement for
11	degree completion at the institution."
12	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the
13	2013-2014 academic year and each subsequent year.
