2 AN ACT TO ADD ONE MEMBER CHOSEN BY THE NORTH CAROLINA CHAPTER OF
3 THE FBI NATIONAL ACADEMY ASSOCIATES TO THE NORTH CAROLINA
4 CRIMINAL JUSTICE EDUCATION AND TRAINING STANDARDS COMMISSION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 17C-3 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 17C-3. North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards
8 Commission established; members; terms; vacancies.

9 (a) There is established the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training
10 Standards Commission, hereinafter called "the Commission." The Commission shall be
11 composed of ~~34~~32 members as follows:

12 ...

13 (4) At-large Groups. – One individual representing and appointed by each of the
14 following organizations: one mayor selected by the League of
15 Municipalities; one law-enforcement training officer selected by the North
16 Carolina Law-Enforcement Training Officers' Association; one criminal
17 justice professional selected by the North Carolina Criminal Justice
18 Association; one sworn law-enforcement officer selected by the North State
19 Law-Enforcement Officers' Association; one member selected by the North
20 Carolina Law-Enforcement Women's Association; one member selected by
21 the North Carolina Chapter of the FBI National Academy Associates; and
22 one District Attorney selected by the North Carolina Association of District
23 Attorneys.

25 (b) The members shall be appointed for staggered terms. The initial appointments shall
26 be made prior to September 1, 1983, and the appointees shall hold office until July 1 of the year
27 in which their respective terms expire and until their successors are appointed and qualified as
28 provided hereafter:

29 For the terms of one year: one member from subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of this
30 section, serving as a police chief; three members from subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of this
31 section, one serving as a police official, and two criminal justice officers; ~~one member~~two
32 members from subdivision (4) of subsection (a) of this section, one appointed by the North
33 Carolina Chapter of the FBI National Academy and one appointed by the North Carolina
34 Law-Enforcement Training Officers' Association; and two members from subdivision (5) of
35 subsection (a) of this section, one appointed by the Governor and one appointed by the
36 Attorney General.

2 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 17C-5(a) reads as rewritten:

3 "(a) The Commission shall elect one of the members of the Commission as Chairman at
4 the first regular meeting after July 1 of each year. The ex officio members shall not be eligible
5 for election as Chairman. In the event of a tie vote of the members of the Commission, the
6 Chairman shall have the deciding vote."

7 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
