A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN INCREASED PENALTY FOR IMPAIRED BOATING 3 RESULTING IN DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY AND TO CLARIFY THE PENALTY FOR 4 IMPAIRED BOATING, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE 5 ON WILDLIFE RESOURCES. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known as Sheyenne's Law. 7 8 **SECTION 2.** Article 1 of Chapter 75A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 9 new section to read: 10 "§ 75A-10.3. Death or serious injury by impaired boating; repeat offenses. Death by Impaired Boating. - A person commits the offense of death by impaired 11 12 boating if all of the following apply: 13 (1) The person unintentionally causes the death of another person. 14 The person was engaged in the offense of impaired boating under (2) 15 G.S. 75A-10(b1). The commission of the offense in subdivision (2) of this subsection is the 16 (3) 17 proximate cause of the death. 18 Serious Injury by Impaired Boating. – A person commits the offense of serious injury (b) 19 by impaired boating if all of the following apply: 20 The person unintentionally causes serious injury to another person. (1) 21 **(2)** The person was engaged in the offense of impaired boating under 22 G.S. 75A-10(b1). 23 The commission of the offense in subdivision (2) of this subsection is the (3) proximate cause of the serious injury. 24 25 Aggravated Serious Injury by Impaired Boating. - A person commits the offense of aggravated serious injury by impaired boating if all of the following apply: 26 27 The person unintentionally causes serious injury to another person. (1) The person was engaged in the offense of impaired boating under 28 (2) 29 G.S. 75A-10(b1). 30 The commission of the offense in subdivision (2) of this subsection is the (3) proximate cause of the serious injury. 31 32 The person has a previous conviction of impaired boating under (4) G.S. 75A-10(b1) within seven years of the date of the offense. 33 34 Aggravated Death by Impaired Boating. – A person commits the offense of aggravated 35 death by impaired boating if all of the following apply:



The person unintentionally causes the death of another person.

SECTION 3. G.S. 75A-10(b4) reads as rewritten:

"(b4) A person who violates subsection (b1) of this section is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of and upon conviction, in addition to any other penalty imposed, shall be fined not less than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)."

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2016, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
