shall study the feasibility of requiring the Human Relations Commission, within the Department		
of Administration, to seek status with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission as a fair		
employment practice agency (FEPA) pursuant to section 706 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e-5 for charges filed by an employee of an employer that regularly employs 15 or		
more employees.
