2	AN ACT TO REPEAL THE CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION ALLOWING THE	
3	REGULATION OF CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON.	
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
5	SECTION 1. Section 30 of Article I of the North Carolina Constitution reads as	
6	rewritten:	
7	"Sec. 30. Militia and the right to bear arms.	
8	A well regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people	
9	to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed; and, as standing armies in time of peace are	
10	dangerous to liberty, they shall not be maintained, and the military shall be kept under strict	
11	subordination to, and governed by, the civil power. Nothing herein shall justify the practice of	
12	carrying concealed weapons, or prevent the General Assembly from enacting penal statutes	
13	against that practice."	
14	SECTION 2. The amendment set out in Section 1 of this act shall be submitted to the	
15	qualified voters of the State at a statewide election to be conducted in November of 2018, which	
16	election shall be conducted under the laws then governing elections in the State. The question to	
17	be used in the voting systems and ballots shall be:	
18	"[] FOR [] AGAINST	
19	A constitutional amendment to repeal the provision which provides that the General	
20	Assembly may prohibit the practice of carrying concealed weapons."	
21	SECTION 3. If a majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of the amendment	
22	set out in Section 1 of this act, the State Board of Elections shall certify the amendment to the	
23	Secretary of State. The Secretary of State shall enroll the amendment so certified among the	
24	permanent records of that office. The amendment set out in Section 1 of this act becomes effective	
25	upon certification.	
26	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
