Referred to: 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A PERSON DRIVING AN AUTOMOBILE WHILE 3 EXERCISING DUE CARE IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY FOR ANY INJURY TO 4 ANOTHER IF THE INJURED PERSON WAS PARTICIPATING IN A PROTEST OR 5 DEMONSTRATION AND BLOCKING TRAFFIC IN A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AT 6 THE TIME OF THE INJURY. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.** The title of Article 43B of Chapter 1 of the General Statutes reads as 9 rewritten: 10 "Article 43B. 11 "Defense of Charitable Immunity Abolished; and Qualified Immunity for Volunteers. Immunities and Other Defenses." 12 **SECTION 2.** Article 43B of Chapter 1 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 13 14 new section to read: 15 "§ 1-539.13 Immunity from civil liability for certain automobile drivers. A person driving an automobile who is exercising due care and injures another person 16 17 who is participating in a protest or demonstration and is blocking traffic in a public right-of-way is 18 immune from civil liability for the injury. A person shall not be immune from civil liability if the actions leading to the injury 19 (b) 20 were willful or wanton." 21 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to injuries 22

occurring on or after that date.
