A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE ACTUALLY GET RID OF COMMON CORE ACT.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-12(9c), the State Board of Education 5 shall repeal the North Carolina Mathematics Standard Course of Study that was adopted by the 6 State Board in June 2010, and implemented beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, and 7 shall adopt a mathematics standard course of study that is consistent with the Minnesota K-12 8 Academic Standards in Mathematics (2007) with any necessary revisions to meet the needs of 9 North Carolina. The mathematics standard course of study adopted by the State Board shall 10 meet the benchmarks set forth in Foundations for Success: The Final Report of the National Mathematics Advisory Panel, U.S. Department of Education: Washington, DC, 2008, and shall 11 12 provide that local school administrative units shall only offer the traditional sequence of 13 mathematics courses of (i) Algebra I, (ii) Geometry, and (iii) Algebra II that were effective for 14 the 2011-2012 school year in lieu of Math I, Math II, and Math III. Local school administrative 15 units shall be required to offer course options aligned with the traditional sequence of mathematics courses that were effective for the 2011-2012 school year for students to satisfy 16 the graduation requirement for a fourth credit in mathematics. The State Board shall adopt 17 18 student assessments consistent with the changes to the North Carolina Mathematics Standard 19 Course of Study required by this section. The changes to the mathematics standard course of 20 study required by this section shall be taught and assessed beginning with the 2018-2019 school 21 year.

22 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-12(9c), the State Board of Education 23 shall repeal the North Carolina English Language Arts Standard Course of Study that was adopted by the State Board in June 2010, and implemented beginning with the 2012-2013 24 25 school year, and shall adopt the English language arts standard course of study that is set forth 26 in An English Language Arts Curriculum Framework for American Public Schools: A Model 27 (for use by any state or school district without charge), Professor Sandra Stotsky at the 28 University of Arkansas, February 2013. The State Board may make the minimal revisions 29 necessary to ensure the standards meet the needs of North Carolina. The State Board shall 30 adopt student assessments consistent with the changes required by this section. The English 31 language arts standard course of study adopted pursuant to this section shall be taught and 32 assessed beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.

33 **SECTION 3.** By March 15, 2018, the State Board of Education shall submit a 34 report to the General Assembly, in accordance with G.S. 120-29.5, and the Joint Legislative 35 Education Oversight Committee containing at least the following information:
