2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR SECOND DEGREE TRESPASS ONTO
3	CERTAIN PREMISES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-159.13 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 14-159.13. Second degree trespass.
7	(a) Offense. – A person commits the offense of second degree trespass if, without
8	authorization, he enters or remains on premises of another:
9	(1) After he has been notified not to enter or remain there by the owner, by a
10	person in charge of the premises, by a lawful occupant, or by another
11	authorized person; or
12	(2) That are posted, in a manner reasonably likely to come to the attention of
13	intruders, with notice not to enter the premises.
14	(b) Classification. – Second Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, second
15	degree trespass is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
16	(c) <u>A violation of subsection (a) of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor if the offense</u>
17	occurs in a multi-occupancy bathroom, shower, or changing facility."
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2017, and applies to
19	offenses committed on or after that date.
