- AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO EXPAND REFUELING AND VEHICLE
 MAINTENANCE CAPABILITIES AT THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL STATION IN
 HUNTERSVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 7 Public Safety the sum of six hundred forty-three thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$643,150) 8 in nonrecurring funds for the 2024-2025 fiscal year to be used for the following purposes at the 9 State Highway Patrol Station in Huntersville, North Carolina:

- 10 Six hundred forty thousand dollars (\$640,000) for fuel infrastructure to (1)include an above-ground storage tank, fuel dispenser, FuelMaster Live 11 functionality, and a concrete island with an awning, lights, and electrical 12 13 outlets. 14 (2)Three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for an air compressor for filling tires to be located on the concrete island funded in subdivision (1) of this section. 15 One hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for a vehicle vacuum to be located on the 16 (3) concrete island funded in subdivision (1) of this section. 17 SECTION 1.(b) The Department of Public Safety shall enter into a memorandum of 18 19 agreement with the Department of Transportation for the creation, use, and maintenance of the
- 20 items funded by this section.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2024.
