CHAPTER 1220  
SENATE BILL 852

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$100,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR  
2 THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING LAND FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATE  
3 PARK AT LAKE WACCAMAW IN COLUMBUS COUNTY.

5 WHEREAS, there has been a marked increase in the amount of leisure time  
6 available to the citizens of North Carolina, causing a need for an increase in public outdoor  
7 recreational facilities; and

8 WHEREAS, the State Parks and State Forests Study Commission has designated the  
9 lower Cape Fear area, composed of Brunswick and New Hanover counties, and portions of  
10 Pender and Columbus counties as one of six areas in which a State Park is urgently needed; and

11 WHEREAS, Lake Waccamaw, a natural lake having an area in excess of 8,900  
12 acres, is a State owned lake administered by the Division of State Parks of the Department of  
13 Conservation and Development, and is particularly suited by its location, natural beauty, and  
14 potential for boating, swimming, and other recreational activities for the creation of a State  
15 Park to serve this region; and

16 WHEREAS, none of the land adjoining Lake Waccamaw is now owned or  
17 controlled by the Division of State Parks, and such public ownership is vital in order that all  
18 citizens of the lower Cape Fear region and the State of North Carolina may have access to said  
19 Lake, and may have free enjoyment and use thereof; and

20 WHEREAS, acquisition of lands adjoining Lake Waccamaw for the creation of a  
21 State Park is in the best interest of the people of the State of North Carolina.

22 NOW, THEREFORE,

24 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

26 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund, the sum of fifty  
27 thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to the Division of State Parks of the Department of Conservation  
28 and Development to be used for the purchase of lands adjoining Lake Waccamaw in Columbus  
29 County which are deemed necessary for the creation of a State Park.

30 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

31 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the day of its  
32 ratification.

33 In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 1st day of July, 1969.
