SENATE BILL 734

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE, LEASE, EXCHANGE, JOINT USE OF PROPERTY  
2 BETWEEN AND AMONG LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AND STATE AGENCIES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:  
5

6 **Section 1.** Chapter 160 of the General Statutes is hereby amended by inserting  
7 therein a new Section 61.2 to read as follows:

8 **"G.S. 160-61.2. Sale, lease, exchange, and joint use of governmental property.** (a) For the  
9 purposes of this Section "governmental unit" shall include any municipality or agency thereof;  
10 any county or agency thereof; any board of education of a school administrative unit; the State  
11 Highway Commission; and any other department, agency, board of commission of the State.

12 (b) Any governmental unit may, upon such terms and conditions as it deems wise,  
13 exchange with, lease to, lease from, sell to, purchase from, or enter into agreements regarding  
14 the joint use by, any other governmental unit of any interest in real property which it may own.

15 (c) Action authorized by the preceding subsection shall be taken by the governing body  
16 or other body or department or agency in charge of the property of the governmental unit.  
17 Action taken hereunder by a municipality or agent thereof, county or agency thereof, or a board  
18 of education of a school administrative unit shall be taken only after a public hearing on the  
19 proposed action, notice of which shall have been published twice in a newspaper having  
20 general circulation in the county or municipality, the first publication of which shall have been  
21 published at least 15 days prior to the date set for the public hearing. Action hereunder by any  
22 department, agency, or board of the State, other than the State Highway Commission, shall be  
23 taken only after approval thereof by the Division of Property Control and Disposition of the  
24 Department of Administration."

25 **Sec. 2.** All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

26 **Sec. 3.** This Act shall be effective upon its ratification.
